Regulatory responsibilities of Local Governing Bodies

<u>Chapter 102.42</u> A municipality or county which issues building or other permits shall notify the Department or conservation district within 5 days of receipt of an application for a permit involving an earth disturbance activity consisting of 1 acre (0.4 hectare) or more.

<u>Chapter 102.43</u> With the exception of local stormwater approvals or authorizations, a municipality or county may not issue building or other permit or approval to those proposing or conducting earth disturbance activities requiring a Department permit until the Department or Conservation District has issued the Erosion Control Permit or the appropriate NPDES Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated With Construction Activities under Chapter 102.5.
